REPORT ON PUBLIC DONATIONS RECEIVED 2020/2021

Thank you once again for your support over the last financial year. The organisation as promised has requested our auditors to review all funds received to ensure they were spent for the intended purposes.

Through your generous support the following was achieved in 2020/2021:

- Clients coming out of incarceration were able to be re-settled with the necessities to start a new life such as household white goods, clothing, basic food supplies/groceries.
- Assistance to young expectant mothers in custody with essential items for birth.
- Clients were assisted with obtaining employment through the following:
 - Client Case costs not covered by existing program agreements eg. obtaining client information such as driver licence fees, birth certificates etc.
 - Provision of training and equipment eg. Gym equipment for a client to commence work as a personal trainer; laptop stationery and school supplies to allow clients to commence studies.
 - Repairs to a client's vehicle allowing him to commence employment in the restaurant industry.
 - Telecommunications – provision of basic mobile phones and credit to assist with employment and rehabilitation initiatives.

Attached is a letter from our auditors in relation to their review of funds utilised in 2020/2021. Any surplus funds have been carried forward to 2021/2022 to undertake the same initiatives assisting our clients in and out of the justice system.
